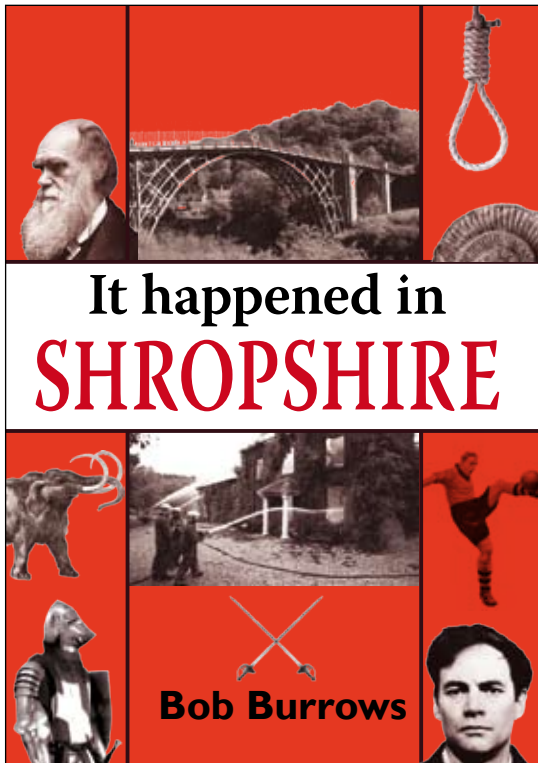

IT HAPPENED IN SHROPSHIRE



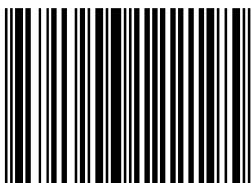
It Happened in Shropshire is a vibrant and compelling account of the county's diverse heritage; its heroes, its battles, its discoveries, its crimes.
